FOBS will be on the playground every Friday at 3-15pm selling ice lollies and ice cream for 50p...yum!

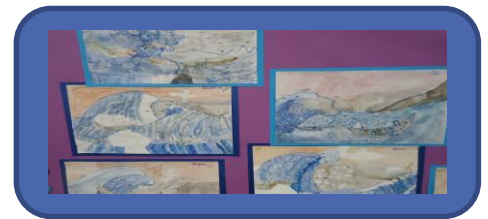
