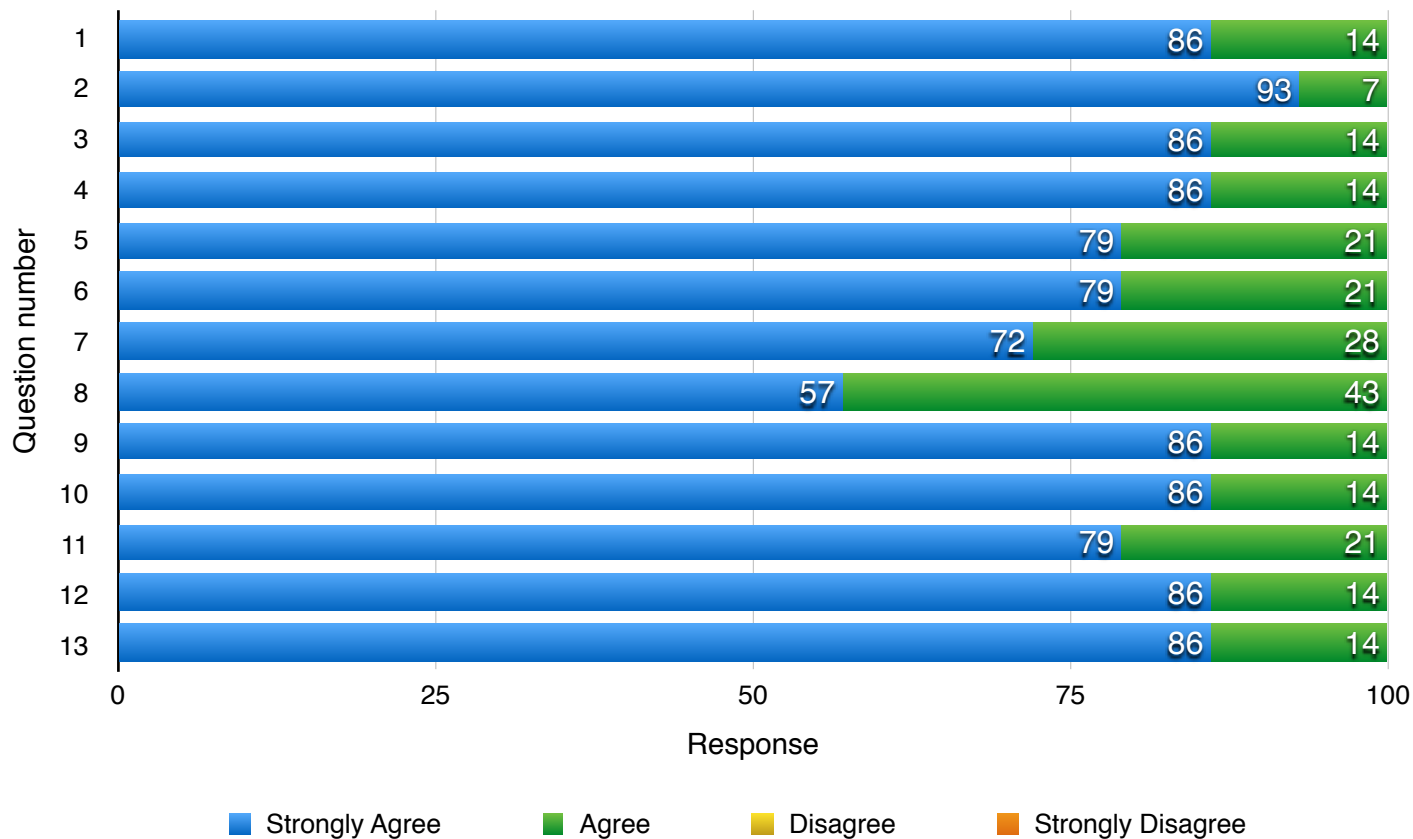


Parent Survey March 2018

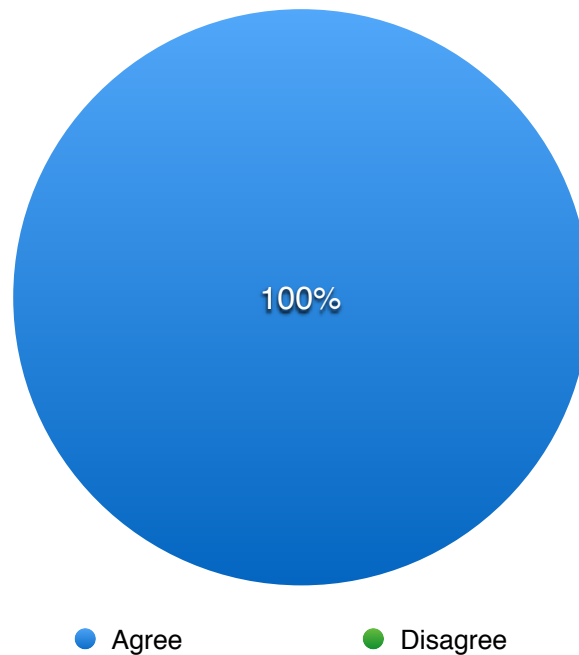

There were 14 completed surveys submitted with 13 questions. This returned 182 responses. The analysis can be found below.
