Class 1

Class 1 have been reading the book 'Here We Are' by Oliver Jeffers. Inspired by the ideas in this book we have written a song, a poem and thought about how the people on this planet are wonderfully different. In maths we have been carrying out addition and subtraction. For the last fortnight we have been geographers. We have looked at maps of our local area, identified features and thought about how the land is used.

Class 2

Class 2 have been reading 'The Whale' by Ethan and Vita Murrow. We have been writing our own version of the story. In maths we have been learning about multiplication (please learn the times tables at home). In our topic work we have begun our work on sustainability.

Class 3

In literacy the children have carried out work based on 'Why the Whales Came'. They have been analysing characters and looking at the poem 'The Harvest Moon' by Ted Hughes. In maths the children have been exploring mental strategies for subtraction. In science the children have built a parallel circuit which would be suitable for Christmas tree lights and made Electric Eel games. Class 3 have also carried out a school dinner survey. They have chatted with the school cook, who is now going to make changes based on their good ideas.
