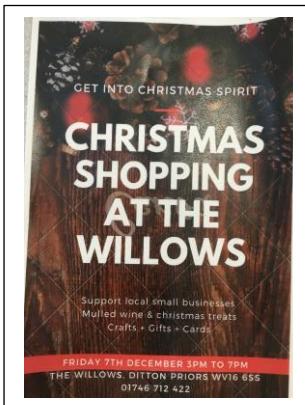
Reception children have been writing their own version of the wonderful story 'The Dog that Saved Christmas.'
