Free to a good home.....Ryan in Class 3 has 2 healthy goldfish and aquarium to give to a loving home! Please contact the school if you are interested.

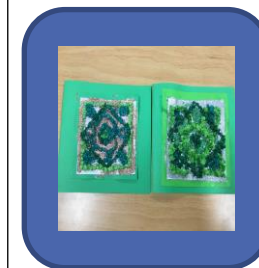
IN THE PICTURE
