CLASS 1



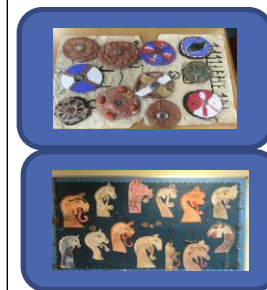
