Year 3/4	Foundation Year	 Phonics 1&2 Basic greetings/introductions (revision Y4) Autumn 1: Superheroes (LA) In this unit the children will: Recognise, recall, and remember the 6 colours presented in French. Recognise and remember the high frequency verbs: '1 am called', '1 have', '1 live', '1 am' and '1 am able'. Present and describe themselves as a superhero. Autumn 2: Dans ma ville/ in my town (LA) In this unit the children will learn how to: Recognise, recall, and remember up to 7 places in the town in French. Try to spell some of these nouns with the correct indefinite article/determiner. Attempt to build a sentence using the structure 'il y a' (there is) plus the noun and the correct indefinite article/determiner. 	 Spring 1: Instruments (E) In this unit the children will: Recognise, recall and spell up to 10 instruments in French with the correct definite article/determiner. Understand articles/determiners better and that the definite article/determiner 'the' has a plural form in French. Learn to say and write 'I play an instrument' in French using the high frequency 1st person regular verb 'je joue' (I play) with up to 10 different instruments. Spring 2: les legumes/Vegetables (E) In this unit the children will learn how to: Name and recognise up to 10 vegetables in French. Attempt to spell some of these nouns (including the correct determiner/article) Learn simple vocabulary to facilitate a role play about buying vegetables from a market stall. Say if they would like one kilo or a half kilo of a particular vegetable or selection 	 Summer 1: Les saisons (seasons) (E) Recognise, recall and remember the 4 seasons in French. Recognise, recall and remember a short phrase for each season in French. Say which season is their favourite in French. Summer 2: La date/The date (I) In this unit the children will learn how to: Repeat and recognise the months of the year in French. Ask when somebody has a birthday and say when they have their birthday. Say the date in French. Create a French calendar. Recognise key dates in the French calendar.

Spring 1: Fruits In this unit the children will learn to: Name and recognise up to 10 fruits in French. Attempt to spell some of these nouns. Ask somebody in French if they like a particular fruit. Say what fruits they like and dislike. 	Summer 1: Les vetements/clothes (I) . Repeat and recognise the vocabulary for a variety of clothes in French. . Use the appropriate genders and articles for these clothes. . Use the verb PORTER in French with increasing confidence. . Say what they wear in different weather/situations. . Describe clothes in terms of their colour and apply adjectival agreement. .Use the possessives with increased accuracy.
		Autumn 2: Les animaux/ Animals (E) In this unit the children will learn how to: • Recognise, recall, and spell up to 10 animals in French with their correct determiners/ indefinite articles. • Understand that there are more determiners/ articles in French than in English. • Use and become more familiar with the high-frequency 1st person conjugated verb 'je suis' (I am), from the infinitive verb 'être' (to be).	 Spring 2: Je peux/I am able In this unit the children will learn to Recognise, recall and spell 10 action verbs in French. Use these verbs in the infinitive to form positive and negative sentence structures with 'je peux' (I am able) and 'je ne peux pas' (I am not able). Attempt to combine positive and negative sentence structures to form longer and more complex sentences using the conjunctions 'et' (and / 'mais' (but). 	Summer 2: Little Red Riding Hood In this unit the children will learn: . a familiar story in a different language . vocabulary for up to 8 parts of the body . 3 different words for "the" . simple phrases from a story .phonics for "ch" "ou" "on" + silent letters

Understand articles/determiners better and that the definite article/determiner 'the' has a plural form in French. Learn to say and write 'I play an instrument' in French using the high frequency 1st person regular verb 'je joue' (I play) with up to 10 different instruments. Autumn 2: Seasons In this unit children will: Recognise, recall and remember the 4 seasons in French. Say which season is their favourite in French 	 Spring 1: Vegetables (E) In this unit the children will learn how to: Name and recognise up to 10 vegetables in French. Attempt to spell some of these nouns (including the correct determiner/article) Learn simple vocabulary to facilitate a role play about buying vegetables from a market stall. Say if they would like one kilo or a half kilo of a particular vegetable or selection of vegetables. SPRING 2: Ice Creams (E) In this unit children will learn how to: Name and recognise up to 10 different flavours for ice creams. Ask for an ice-cream in French using 'je voudrais'. Say what flavour they would like a cone or a small pot/tub of ice-cream. 	 Summer 1: My family In this unit children will learn to: Tell somebody the members, names and various ages of either their own or a fictional family in French. Continue to count in French, with the option of reaching 100, enabling students to say the age of various family members. Understand the concept of the possessive adjectives 'mon', 'ma' and 'mes' in French. Move from 1st person singular to 3rd person singular of the two high frequency verbs used in this unit: s'appeler (to be called) and avoir (to have). Summer 2: En Classe (I)/ In the classroom In this unit children will: Remember and recall 12 classroom objects with their indefinite article/determiner. Replace an indefinite article/determiner with a possessive adjective. Say and write what they have and do not have in their pencil case.

Spring 1: Au salon de the/At the Tea Room In this unit the children will learn how to: Remember and recall a wide variety of foods, snacks, and drinks (with their indefinite article/determiner) typically served in a salon de thé. To understand better how to change a singular noun to plural form. Perform a short role-play ordering what they would like to eat and drink. 	Summer 1: Le weekend/ The weekend (P) In this unit the children will learn how to: • Ask what the time is in French. • Tell the time accurately in French. • Learn how to say what they do at the weekend in French. • Learn to integrate connectives into their work. • Present an account of what they do and at what time at the weekend. Conjugate the irregular verb FAIRE enabling the students to say what sports they play and what sports they do not play. • Understand the concept of de la, de l' and du when you say you play a sport in French.

Attempt to create a longer phrase using the conjunctions et ("and") or mais ("but"). Autumn 2: Les habitats/habitats (P) In this unit the children will learn how to: Tell somebody in French the key elements that animals and plants need to survive in their habitat. Tell somebody in French examples of the most common habitats for plants and animals and give a named example of these habitats. Tell somebody in French which animals live in these different habitats. 	 Spring 1: Quel temps fait-il?/ What is the weather?(I) Repeat and recognise the vocabulary for weather in French.
