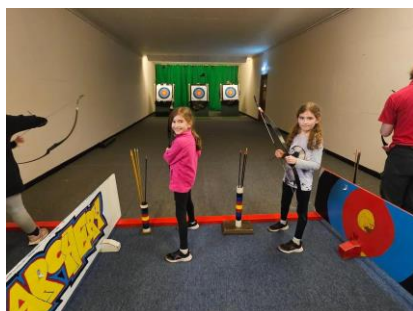

Hello everyone,

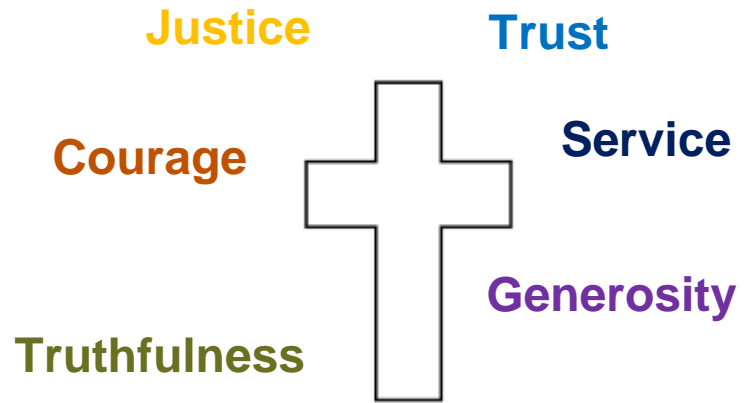
It has been a very busy first week back, with lots going on in school!

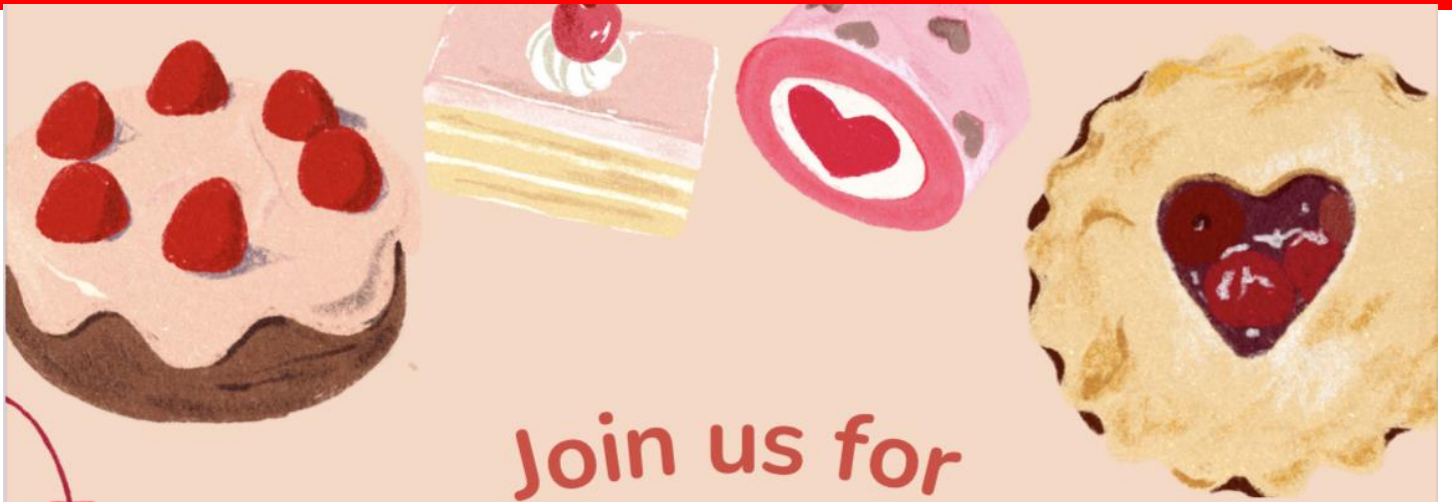

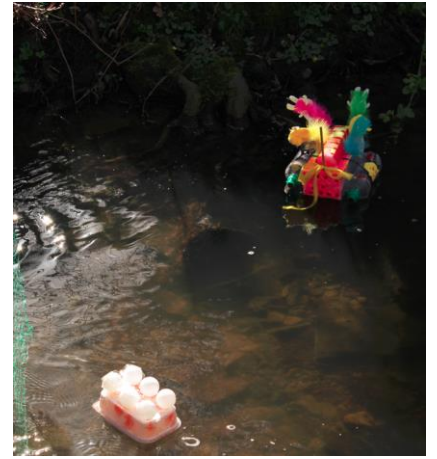
