We still have a number of job vacancies for Breakfast and After School Club. Various hours available. Please speak to Kerry in the school office if you are interested in joining the team.

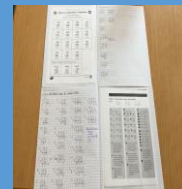
## IN THE PICTURE
