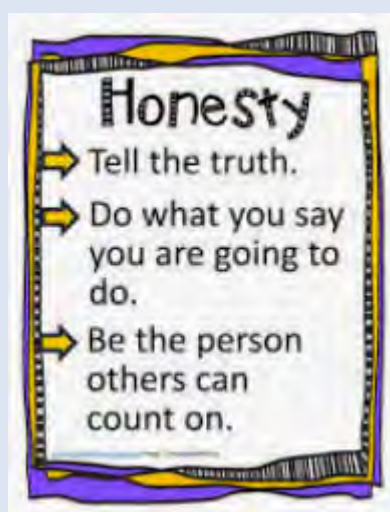
In the current hot weather, please ensure that your child has a hat and water bottle in school, and suncream has been applied before they come in. Thank you for your assistance.

Music bursaries available for Shropshire children aged 7-11

Is your child keen to learn music but the costs are too much to manage?

If you are in receipt of benefits (including Child Tax Credits) and are on a low income, or have exceptional circumstances the Jon Hayward Memorial Trust may be able to help.

We award bursaries on an annual basis to part-fund the cost of music lessons for children who are prevented from pursuing their interest by their family's financial situation and the lack of funding from elsewhere.

Our support can be for lessons in school, or arranged privately. In all cases, proof of family income will be required. Forms received by 11th July will have priority but we will consider applications at other times of the year if we are able to; we have a total of 20 bursaries available for the next academic year.

Jon Hayward was a well-known Shropshire folk musician and singer who died of cancer in 2006, aged 53. He loved sharing his enthusiasm for music, especially with children.

Family and friends, with the support of numerous musicians, have been fundraising since 2007 in order to enable children, who might not otherwise get the opportunity, to access music. The continuation of this support has been made possible by a legacy administered by a Bridgnorth church.
