The Class 2 reverse advent calendar is underway with some fabulous wishes from the children and the much needed donations for the Bridgnorth food bank



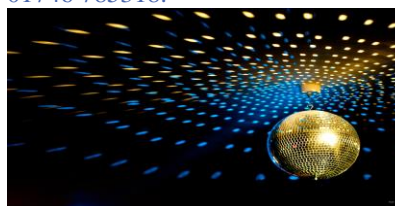
Class 3 have been getting in the Christmas spirit this week making their very yummy looking Christmas puddings!
