Class 1

Class 1 have been writing their own books this week. They have chosen their own vehicles that the pigeon cannot drive. We have had 'Do Not Let the Pigeon Drive the Police Car, Fire Engine, Aeroplane and Hot Air Balloon.

In maths we have been looking at the properties of shapes. We have been on a shape hunt and made shapes from lolly sticks and straws. For our topic work we have made salt dough. Class 1 really enjoyed getting their hands doughy. We talked about how the salt dough felt before and after cooking.

Class 2

Class 2 have been learning about writing instructions for a healthy sandwich. In maths we have been learning about equivalent fractions and fractions of shapes and amounts. We have been busy making our Egyptian Death Masks using mixed media and skills - collage, painting, bead decoration and joining techniques. In science we have been learning about sound, how it travels and the role of the ear in collecting sounds.

Class 3

Class 3 have been focussing on reading and comprehension skills in literacy. In addition to completing their reading comprehension exercises the children have their own questions for others to tackle. In maths we have concentrated on arithmetic skills and revised number work, fractions, decimals and percentages. Now we have started our topic on angles. In science we have been filtering stream water, taking inspiration from water treatment works!
