Class 1

Class 1 have started their Splash topic! Our class book for literacy is 'Dear Greenpeace'. It is about a little girl called Emily who finds a whale in her pond. She writes letters to Greenpeace to ask for information. The children have written letters and postcards. Their writing has been fabulous! In science the children have made a weather station in the playground to measure the different types of weather. We have been learning about the artist Hokusai. We have used polystyrene tiles to make wave shapes and have printed our own versions of the 'Great Wave', they look amazing!

Class 2

Class 2 have been learning about Africa. We have been discovering all about Ananse the mischievous spider in Literacy and writing our very own tales. In Maths we have been looking at Place Value and brushing up our addition skills. We had so much fun in DT when we investigated smoothies, made and evaluated our own strawberry and banana smoothie creations.

Class 3

Class 3 have been analysing newspaper articles and learning about active and passive sentences. Next week we will be writing our own newspaper articles taking inspiration from events within the Harry Potter stories. In maths we have investigated 3D shapes and built shapes using 'nets'. The hexagonal prisms were the most tricky. We have started work on the circulatory system and will be undertaking our breathing and pulse rate investigations next week. We have been learning about the Shang Dynasty during history and have started cricket in PE lessons. The children have been enjoying swimming lessons at Much Wenlock and have organised the recent KS1 cross country event. We have also done the SAT tests.
