## Easter party

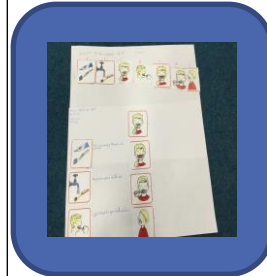
