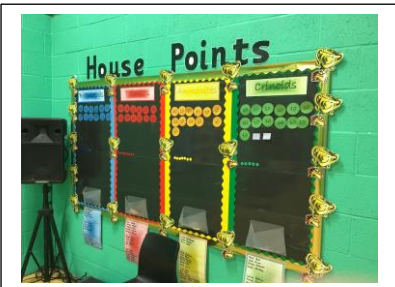

CLASS 1



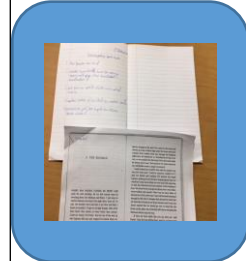
Continuing with the 'Fairy Tale' theme, Class 1 have been making their very own Gingerbread House. Doesn't it look amazing! Well done everyone!
